Project: Monopoly in the Park

Description: Located at the north end of Discovery Meadow in the Guadalupe River Park, the Monopoly game board, is more than 200 times the area of a conventional Monopoly board. The granite and concrete game board is surrounded by picnic tables and trees and the second phase of construction will include stadium seating. This attraction is intended for outdoor Monopoly tournaments.

Location: Adjacent to the Guadalupe River between the Children's Discovery Museum & San Carlos Street

Benefit: Monopoly in the Park is part of the Guadalupe River Park Master Plan to create a walk-able, pedestrian-friendly, and family-oriented Downtown.

Features:

- 2-foot dice cubes
- 30' x 30' game board
- Picnic tables
