Project: O'Donnell's Gardens Park

Description: The O'Donnell's Gardens Park Development project includes the construction of a park at 6th and William Streets in the University Strong Neighborhoods area. In the University Strong Neighborhood Improvement Plan, the University Neighborhood Coalition identified the project was the number one priority on the top ten action items. The plan was approved by the city council in June 2002.

Location: Corner of South Sixth and East William Streets
University Strong Neighborhoods Project Area

Benefit: The project will improve the neighborhood's quality of life as the park will make the area a more desirable place to visit and foster further investment in the neighborhood.

Features: This 1/2 acre park includes:

- Tot lot
- Park lighting
- Picnic tables and seating areas
- Ornamental fencing
- Landscape

Total Costs: \$ 689,000 from San Jose Redevelopment Agency
